First student from SJI awarded SJI Foundation scholarship



Moses Law will begin his undergraduate degree in October at Christ's College, Cambridge, UK.

The St Joseph's Institution Foundation for the Lasallian Mission (SJI Foundation) held a Scholarship Award Lunch for the SJI Foundation – Christ's College Cambridge Scholarship on Sep 2.

This scholarship programme was established in 2017 to mark the 165th anniversary of St Joseph's Institution's (SJI) founding in 1852. Through it, the SJI Foundation will award up to two scholarships to selected candidates from SJI and SJI International to pursue a full-time undergraduate degree at Christ's College, Cambridge, UK. In 2018, the SJI Foundation had awarded the scholarship to its first two recipients from SJI International.

The recipient of the 2020 SJI Foundation – Christ's College Cambridge Scholarship, Moses Law, is a graduate from SJI who went through the six-year Integrated Programme.

The scholarship recipient was selected on a merit-based approach and the scholarship selection committee were unanimous in its endorsement of the recipient who had obtained 45 points in the International Baccalaureate examinations.

The scholarship will help him realise his full potential at the tertiary level by providing partial and un-bonded financial support. The recipient will be pursuing an undergraduate degree in Law at Christ's College.

The recipient recently completed his national service and will commence his studies in October.
